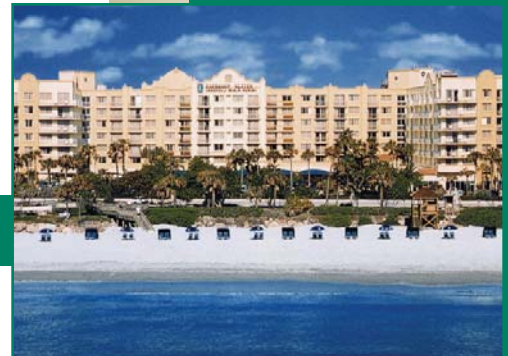
This unique, three-day symposium enables dangerous goods instructors to network and discuss important trends and issues.

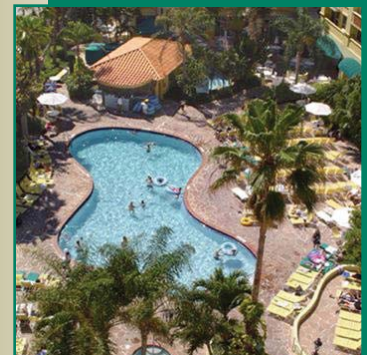
